

ORDINANCE NO. 283

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HAWLEY CITY CODE
CHAPTER 4 PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
2-4-2: COMMISSION ESTABLISHED**

The Council of the City of Hawley does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Hawley established a Public Utilities Commission by Resolution on November 1, 1909 and adopted the general provisions of Minn. Stat. '412.331 thru '412.391; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawley adopted Ordinance 209 by Resolution on May 20, 1996 setting forth the utilities to be included in the Public Utilities Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawley hereby removes from the jurisdiction of the Hawley Public Utilities Commission the registrar of motor vehicles duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council hereby ordains:

SECTION 1: REPEAL.

The City of Hawley does hereby repeal Hawley City Code 2-4-2 which reads as follows:

“A public utilities commission is hereby established pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 412.331. The following utilities shall be within the Commission’s jurisdiction: the water system; the light and power system; the gas system; and the registrar of motor vehicles.”

SECTION 2: AMENDED JURISDICTION.

The jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission shall be amended to remove the registrar of motor vehicles as a utility and Hawley City Code 2-4-2 shall henceforth read as follows:

Hawley City Code 2-4-2. ESTABLISHED.

“A Public Utilities Commission is hereby established pursuant to Minn. Stat. '412.331. The following utilities shall be within the Commission’s jurisdiction: the water system; the light and power system; and the gas system.”

SECTION 3: This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
